Topic: Environmental Consequences of Climate Change

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. All students of VIT-AP are eligible to participate
- Participants should register individually for the conference through the following registration link: https://tinyurl.com/3p9mr7n6
- Last date of registration for the conference as well as poster competition is Monday, April 25, 2022 (5:00 PM)
- 4. There is no registration fee.

Submission

- Each participant should prepare a A4 size poster with texts and relevant visuals.
- 6. Each participant should submit only one poster.
- 7. Posters should be submitted beforehand.
- Last date for submission of posters is Monday, April 25, 2022 (11:00 PM).
- Pre-selected posters will be accepted for presentation.
- 10. Poster can be handmade or digitally designed.
- 11. Poster should be submitted in PDF format
- 12. Participants should email the poster to the following Email ID: vit.apclimateconference@gmail.com
- 13. The name of the file should be participant's full name followed by the word "poster". For example, priyankaghosh_poster
- 14. The subject of the email should be: "International Climate Change Conference Poster Submission"

Presentation

- 15. Participants should join the meeting 05 minutes prior to the starting time of the session.
- Participants must be fully prepared for the presentation beforehand.
- 17. Each participant will have 5 minutes for oral presentation.
- 18. Oral presentation should be in English.
- 19. All the participants must be present in formal attire.
- 20. All participants are requested to maintain decorum during the session.
- 21. The decision taken by the committee/judges shall be final and binding.
- 22. The participants are supposed to check their internet connectivity prior to the meeting. In case of any network issues, the participant will be given 3 to 5 minutes to re-join the meeting. In case, they fail to do so, that may lead to their disqualification.
- 23. During the session, participants are expected to turn on their camera but only the speaker must unmute.
- 24. Exceeding the presentation time may lead to penalty.
- 25. Merit certificates will be provided to the students securing 1st, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up positions.
