Right to information is aimed to inform citizens with vital information of public authorities. It helps in the transparency of information and in containing corruption. The enforcement of the right to information will clash with public interests including efficient operations of the government, optimum allocation of fiscal resources, and preservation of confidentiality of sensitive information. To balance these conflicting interests the Indian government enacted the Right to Information Act, 2005. The current course aims to develop an understanding of the basics of the RTI Act, 2005. The course will also cover the constitution of central and state information commissions in ensuring the fulfilment of the objective of the legislation.
